

# Hilltop Tuition and Participation Requirements 2011-2012

## Monthly Tuition for Families Planning to Work in the Classroom (Co-op)\*

Program/Days	Work Requirements	Monthly Tuition
2 days (Seeds)	2 work days; 1 alt day per month	\$175
3 days (Sprouts)	3 work days; 1 alt day per month	\$225
4 days (Blooms/Blossoms)	4 work days; 1 alt day per month	\$260

*Note: Families requiring a 5-day program may enroll concurrently in the Seeds and Sprouts program upon availability. Monthly tuition for concurrent enrollment is \$340 which is a 15% discount off the combined monthly tuition of the two programs.*

## Monthly Tuition for Families NOT Planning to Work in the Classroom (non Co-Op)

Program/Days	Work Requirements	Monthly Tuition
2 days (Seeds)	None	\$260
3 days (Sprouts)	None	\$345
4 days (Blooms/Blossoms)	None	\$415

*Note: Families requiring a 5-day program may enroll concurrently in the Seeds and Sprouts program upon availability. Monthly tuition for concurrent enrollment is \$515 which is a 15% discount off the combined monthly tuition of the two programs.*

### Tuition Notes

\*Upon availability, families may choose to "buy out" one or more of their co-op required days at the rate of \$35 per work day and \$15 per alternate day.

Families with two or more children simultaneously enrolled receive a 20% discount on the second and/or younger child and subsequent children.

# Hilltop Additional Participation Requirements 2011-2012

Requirement per Family	Buyout Available?	Buyout Amount
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Ways &amp; Means (Fundraising) Obligation</b> - Parents are required to participate in major fundraising events and contribute at least <b>five hours</b> towards the planning and execution of those events per school year. </li> </ul>	Yes	\$300 (\$60 per required hour)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Auction Obligation</b> – Each family is required to collect donations worth \$150 or more to be auctioned off at the school's annual Auction Fundraiser. In addition, each family is required to sell a minimum number of tickets to the event (typically four tickets), and sell a minimum number of raffle tickets (typically \$20 worth). </li> </ul>	Yes	\$300
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Job Obligation</b> - Parents are required to maintain a job or a committee position for the school year, i.e. Board member, librarian, secretary, fundraising committee. </li> </ul>	Yes	\$300
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Maintenance Obligations</b> - Parents are required to perform two maintenance duties per school year, one of which is a maintenance job (such as painting or repair work), and the other of which is a scheduled Clean-Up Day. </li> </ul>	Yes	\$250 (\$125 for Cleanup Day; \$125 for maintenance job)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>General Meetings</b> - Parents are required to attend monthly general meetings held the third Wednesday evening of each month from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. (parents not working in the classroom need only attend the three mandatory General Meetings held in September, January and April). </li> </ul>	No	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Orientation</b> - New parents working in the classroom are required to attend a one day (9am to 1pm) Classroom Mechanics Orientation session before they are scheduled to work in the classroom. <b>All parents</b> (working and non-working) are also required to attend a one day (9am to 1pm) Philosophy Orientation session typically held prior to the start of the school year. </li> </ul>	No
